

## CTV Cruise

Destination: Sugar Ridge Winery

Our meeting location is the Rio Mambo restaurant parking lot in Burleson. Take the Renfro St. exit. Rio Mambo will be visible on the right from the off ramp. For those arriving from Granbury, Cleburne, etc., alternate arrangements can be made to join the cruise in Alvarado at the Dairy Queen on US 67. Let me know so we will be sure and watch for you.

Upon departure from Burleson, we will head South on I-35W, take exit 26 (US-67) and head East.

The picnic is “bring your own.” Do **NOT** bring in any alcoholic beverages. All other beverages are welcome. The optional winery tasting is \$15 and includes about 15 wines. The tasting room is air conditioned. The picnic area is outside but well covered. This winery is like many others in that there is something to satisfy each preference. I have not been to a winery yet that I could not find at least one choice that pleased me. One person’s wine preference is another’s “stain remover.” Despite the winery’s name, not all of their offerings is sweet.

Since the entrance and parking area is gravel, I wouldn’t go to too much trouble to clean up your car. The drive will range from straight and boring to uh, interesting. There are no dirt roads, a short stretch of “vintage” pavement, and NO cattle guards or water crossings.
