

## **By-Laws – 3.3 Competition Committee**

First and foremost, this is not a committee. It is more of a staff assignment. I cannot describe what I SHOULD do because the "official" written description was never clear to me. However, I will describe what I DID do which appeared to be met with universally positive reaction.

Practice Autocross - This is an annual unsanctioned autocross held at Mineral Wells each year. The primary objective of this event was to:

1. Teach autocrossing to the uninformed.
2. Teach autocross event planning/preparation/execution to the uninformed.
3. Test recently tuned, modified, or acquired cars.
4. Practice running an autocross course.
5. Have a great party in a rather austere setting.

The competition "committee chair" is, by default, the event chair for the practice autocross.

I also spoke on the news of some events but, only minimally since the NCCC event coverage was covered by the governor, the NCCC event coordinator, the webmaster, and others on occasion. I would sometimes present relevant topics of interest to those who compete (e.g., equipment purchase, non-NCCC events that might be of interest, etc.). Inquiries and invitations relevant to competitive events are usually forwarded to the competition committee chair as well.
