This is WFAA Chief Weather Anchor Troy Dungan's 31st anniversary as the official spokesman for Santa's Helpers. Joining Troy this year as a spokesperson for the toy campaign is WFAA Meteorologist Pete Delkus.

The 2005 Santa's Helpers Toy Drive was a huge success with more than 73,000 toys collected, providing holiday toys to more than 50,000 needy children throughout the four-county Dallas/Fort Worth area.

The 2006 Toy Drive is November 24 through December 19, 2006.

This year, Santa's Helpers is hosting 5 drive-thru events including:

- Legacy Town Center Thursday, December 7, at the main plaza in front of the Marriott Hotel on Bishop Street, from 4 to 7 p.m.
- Frisco Wednesday, December 13, at the Frisco Fire Station and Safety Town from 4 to 7 p.m.
- Fort Worth Friday, December 15, located at 3401 Lancaster between University and Montgomery in front of the Will Rogers Memorial Coliseum Ticket Office and the Fort Worth Visitors Center, from 5 to 10 p.m.
- Dallas Tuesday, December 19 (2 Locations)
- In front of the WFAA Studios at 606 Young Street in downtown Dallas from 5 to 10 p.m.
- In front of WFAA studios at Victory Plaza near the American Airlines Center from 5 to 10 p.m.
