<b>Charities</b> Sylvia Hoaldrige & Jane B.	Saturday Night	Silent Auction Items and Raffle Drawings
<b>Club Equipment</b> Robert Geyer	Friday thru Sunday	Delivers the Club Trailer to the Event and takes it back to Storage
<b>Corners</b> Richard Downing	Sat & Sun on the Infield Track	These individuals work out on the track, to monitor the participants as they maneuver the course. They call in cones and / or off-road excursions as they occur. This is truly the BEST SEAT at the track for watching the event, under tents w/beverages and chairs
<b>Course Setup</b> Doug McMahan	Friday & Sunday Afternoon on the Infield Track	A group is responsible for setting up the track on Friday Night, based on a course that the Event Committee designs as a Team
<b>Hospitality</b> Jo Anne Smith	Friday Night at the Host Hotel	This group is responsible for the Friday night is a light snack / drink social at the hotel; setting up, refills on items and the cleanup afterwards
<b>Hospitality / Meal</b> Jo Anne Smith	Saturday Night at the Host Hotel	The Food will be catered and they provide a server. This group will be responsible to help setup the area for the social, working the drink section ready along with cleanup afterwards
<b>Worker Lunches</b> <b>CHAIRPERSON NEEDED</b>	Saturday & Sunday	We provide lunch tickets to the workers for Saturday & Sunday - this person controls and distributes those tickets to the functional chairpersons
<b>Parking (Rig)</b> Jim Forsythe	Friday evening along with a few on Saturday & Sunday morning	This is to guide and assist participants where to park their RIGs so that we can fit all of them into the area provided. Most of the activity is Friday evening with a few coming in on Sat & Sun mornings
<b>Pre-Staging</b> Rick Watson	Saturday & Sunday at the NASCAR Garage	This is where we stage the Participants awaiting their turn to go up to the track for their runs. We stage the Vettes by group and by type of driver(s) - the Vettes park in the same spot all weekend. Get up close and personal with the race cars and the participants - this is where you see it all
<b>Registration</b> Carlanne Hickman	Friday evening along with a few on Saturday & Sunday morning	This group is responsible for registering the participants at the track, prior to their Vettes being "teched". They will be responsible for validating the racer's drivers license & NCCC is valid, Sat night meal tickets and the tech sheet. There are a few participants that will need to be registered when they come in Sat & Sun mornings
<b>Staging</b> Starters & TMS	Saturday & Sunday at the entrance to the Infield Track	This group coordinates participants from the pre-staging area up to the Staging area, prior to their turn on the starting line.
<b>Starter</b> Scott Wheeler & David Clark	Saturday & Sunday on the Infield Track	This is the person at the starting line which launches the cars onto the track after a careful check of the racers out on the track - in constant communication with the Timing group
<b>Tech</b> Doc Lambert	Friday evening along with a few on Saturday & Sunday morning	This group is responsible for performing a safety check on the race cars, per the NCCC tech sheet and rule book. If your interested in leardning about Corvette Setup and/or Safety, here is the gig for you
<b>Timing</b> Becky Clark	Setup on Friday evening along with Saturday & Sunday	This group is responsible for running the timing system during the events - the timing system records the participants run (lap) times, which are then posted to timing boards
<b>Timing Equipment</b> David & Becky Clark	Setup on Friday evening along with Saturday & Sunday	This group is responsible for the setting up and maintaining of the timing equipment that allows Timing & Timing Boards to perform their function.
<b>Timing Boards</b> Glenda McMahan	Saturday & Sunday in the NASCAR Garage	This group is responsible for posting the participant's run stickers onto the timing boards along with logging the runs. If you like to see who is the fastest & how the competition stacks up, this is where the proof is.
