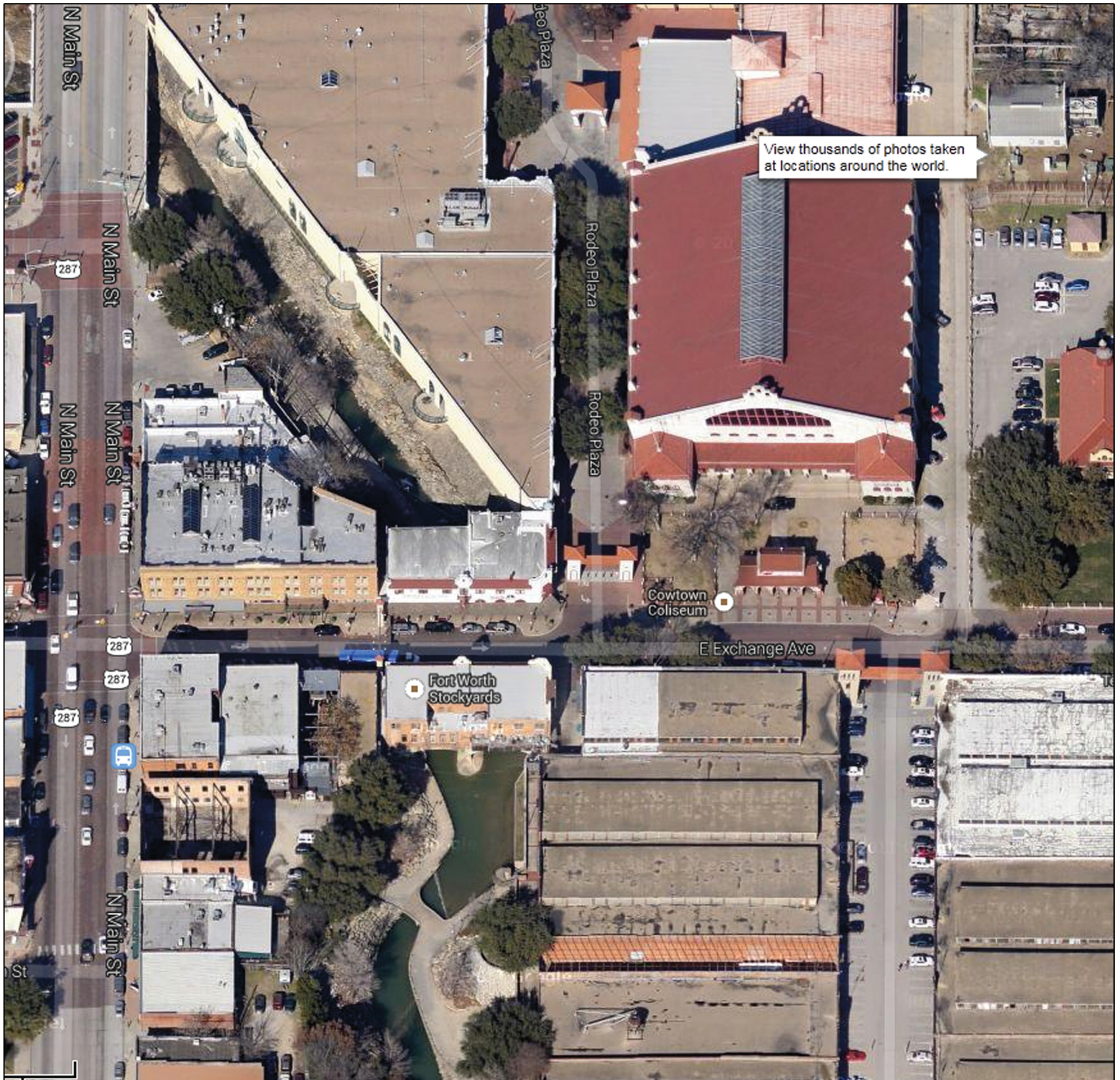

# Coyote Drive In

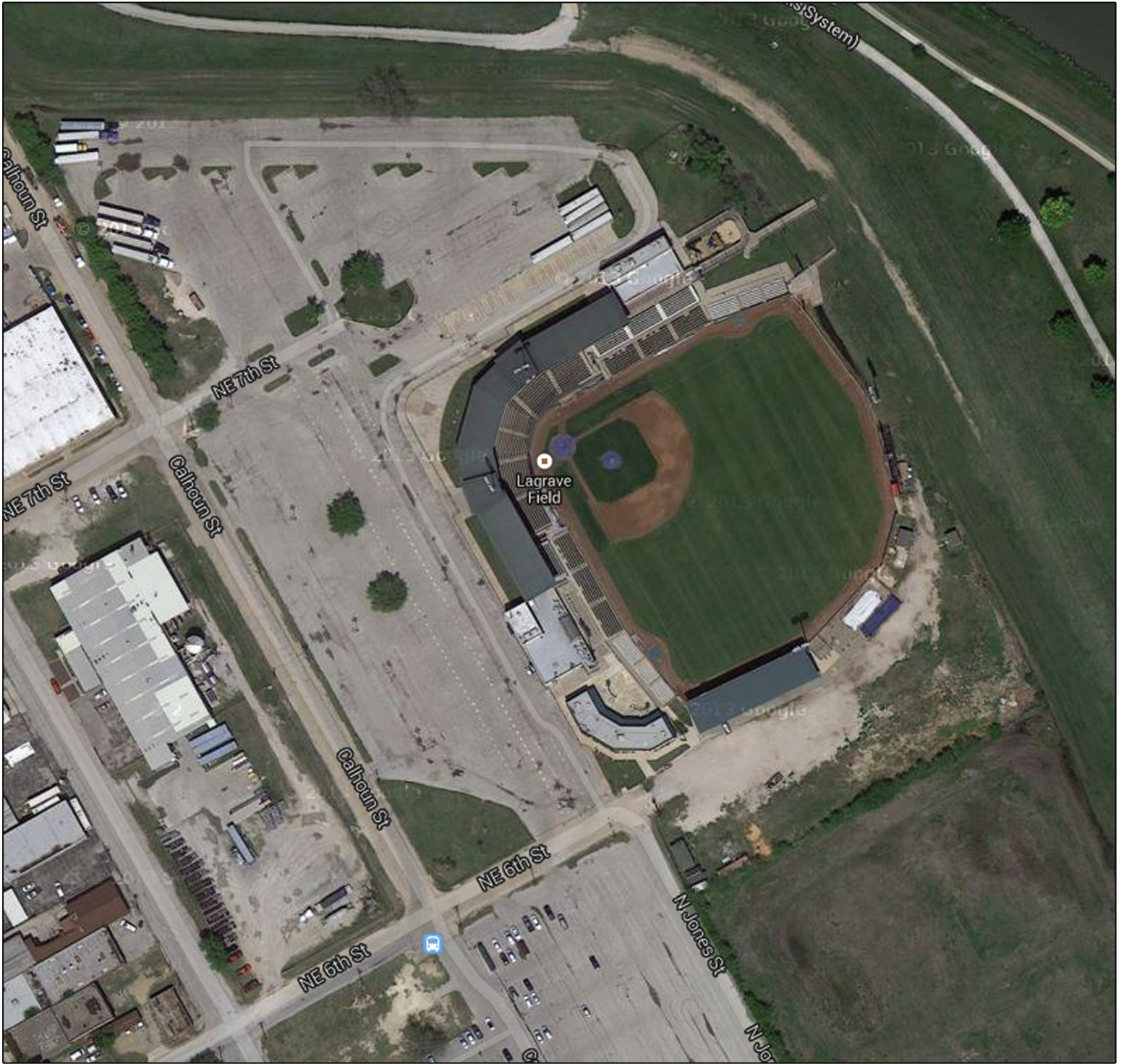


This is just south of where we shot the 30th photo

Not an optimum or memorable photo of any kind at this location - since not inside the field

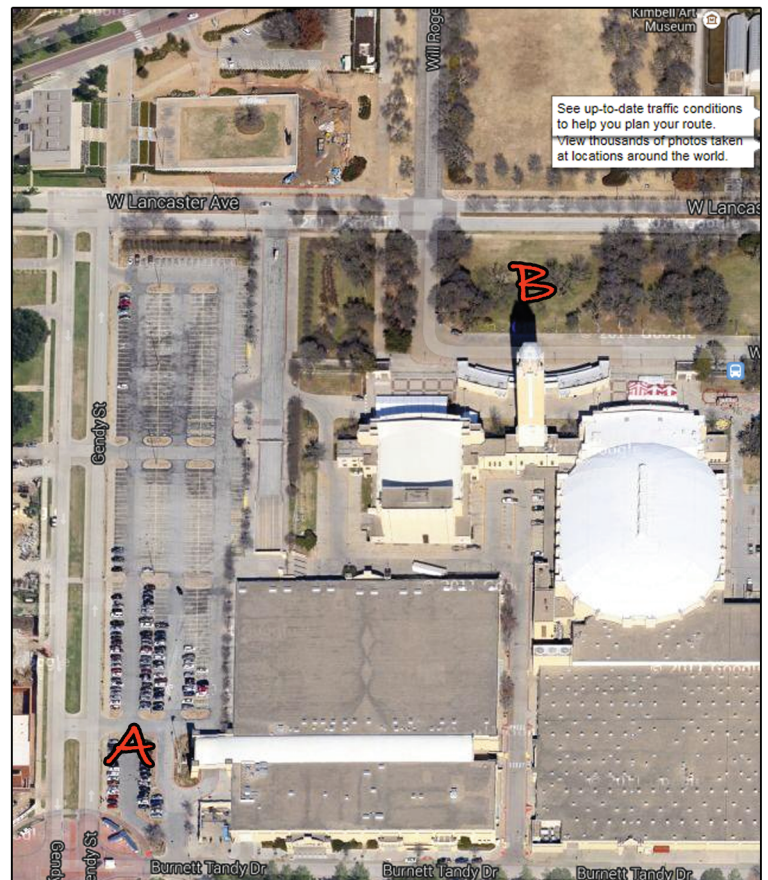


# Will Rogers / Amon Carter

There is no real good angle / direction for a photo due to trees and other obstacles ...nothing really that stands out to make the photo "outstanding"

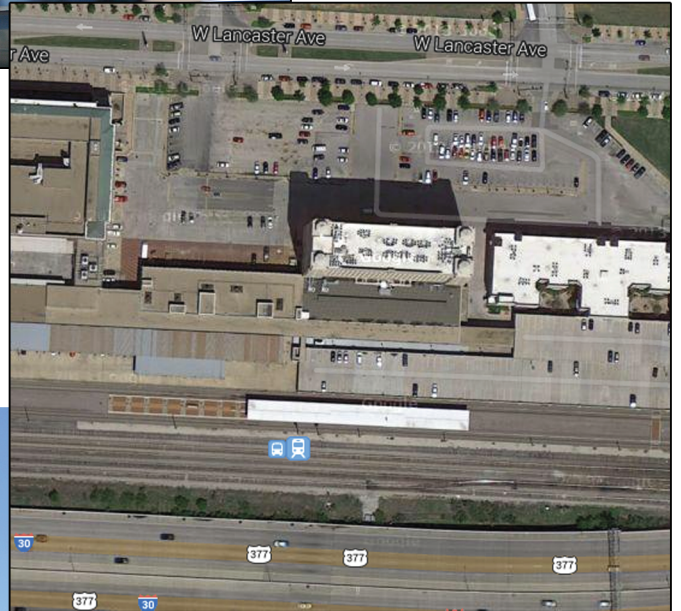


# T & P Train Building



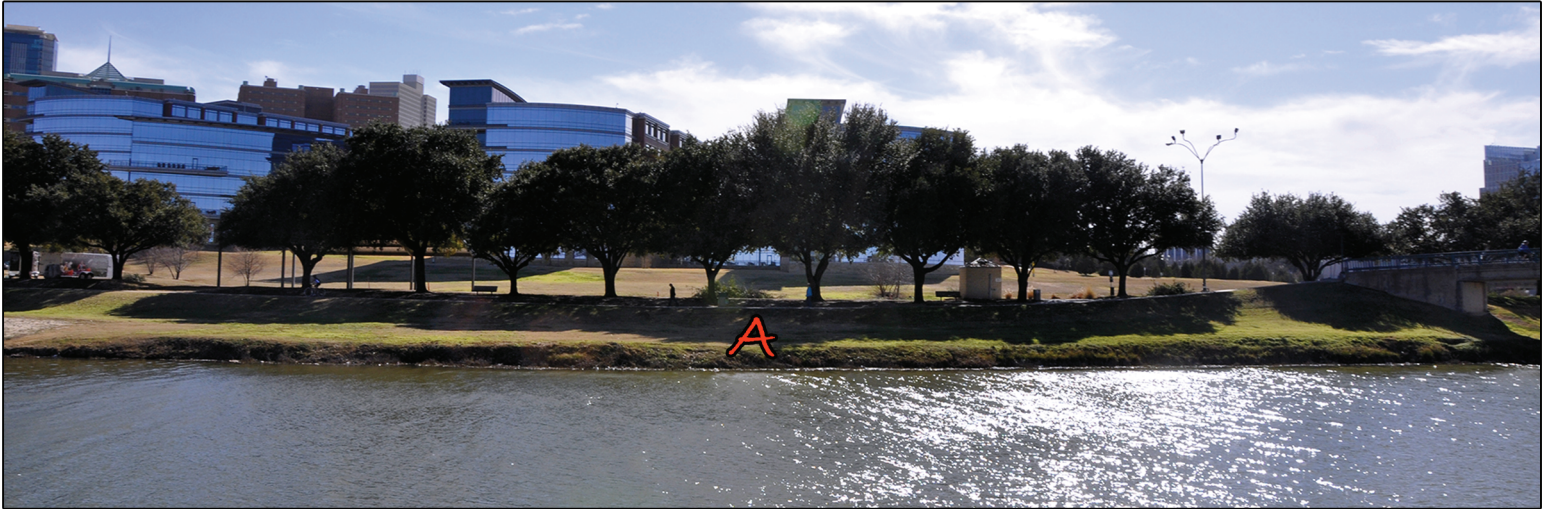
Since these are now Condos, the potential to get an un-occupied parking lot is slim to none marginal arrangement options

The Post Office - to the right has a better parking lot option but again, we would have to block off half of the T&P Parking lot as well



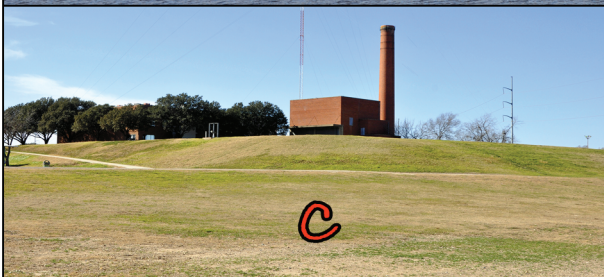


# Banks of the Trinity River
