Cowtown Cruiser Program (CCP) - 2021 Rules / Guidelines

- Entries must be a current Cowtown Vettes member and can be one vehicle per person or couple. Only photos will be accepted. Photos may be submitted in printed or digital format (providing they adhere to the naming standards set forth – separate document. If they do not conform to the naming standards, they will be disqualified since validation becomes virtually impossible. A separate photo and/or image file must be submitted for each point / location listed.
- A minimum of fifty [50] photos must be submitted to qualify for prizes. Entries MUST include an official Cowtown Cruisers log form, available from the Cruiser Chairperson. ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ELEMENTS MUST BE INCLUDED IN EACH PHOTO SUBMITTED:
- 3. Your Chevrolet Corvette (not on a trailer)
- 4. A color copy of the Current Cowtown Cruiser Logo
- 5. You (the entrant)
- 6. An "official sign" as defined below as:
 - A city / town limit or county sign, a government building, national cemeteries, churches, national landmarks, etc. with the name of the city / town, county, state / territory and/or country on it, such as a post office or police station (libraries or schools do not qualify).
 - An authorized Chevrolet dealership may be used to designate a city and state ONLY. However, the first letter of the actual city where the dealer is located is the letter for which you will be credited. (For example: a photo of "Bruce Lowrie Chevrolet" would give you credit for the letter "F" because that dealership is located in Fort Worth, TX.)
 - A sign posted by a government body, which exists in the boundaries of the place it identifies. (Mileage markers or directional signs are not allowed.)
- 7. The name of the Chevrolet dealership, city, town, state, country, etc. MUST appear legibly on the "official sign" in the photo to qualify for points. Any illegible photos or unvalidateable locations will be disqualified for those points.
- You must DRIVE your Corvette (use rental of Corvettes is acceptable). Photos with Corvettes on trailers ARE NOT eligible, this is a CRUISING PROGRAM.
- Photos must qualify as outlined above to be eligible for points. Points are awarded as follows:
 - One [1] point for each City, Town, Township, or Municipality sign from A-Z. Limit one city / point per letter (max. of 78* pts) – official Ghost Towns qualify but the chairperson must be able to validate it – web).
 - One [1] point for each County, Parish, or District sign from A-Z. The word County, Parish, or District MUST appear on the sign as well as the name. Limit one point per letter (max. of 75* points).
 - Cities, Counties, State & Nat'l Parks / Forests outside of Texas count as two [2] pts (adds extra point).
 - One [1] point for each State. The name of the State MUST appear on the sign (max. of 100 points).
 - Five [5] **BONUS points** for obtaining all Cities, all Counties or 48 States for the competition year.
 - One point for a State / National Forest sign. The name as well as "National Forest" MUST appear on the sign (max. of twelve [12] points per year).

- One [1] point for a **State or U.S. National Park**. The name as well as "State / National Park" MUST appear on the sign (max. of twelve [12] points per year).
- One [1] extra bonus point for using a Historical Marker sign with a city, county or state name on it. It counts for the city, county or state named on it. This is in addition to any out-of-Texas extra points.
- Two [2] points for each <u>National Corvette Museum</u>, <u>NCRS</u>, <u>Eureka Springs</u>, <u>Hot Springs</u>, <u>or other</u> "<u>Corvette</u>" <u>Events</u> (NCM) as published on their website or their publication of "America's Sports Car" (maximum of ten [12] points per year).
- Social / NCCC / Corvette Event photos should be identifiable for the official Sponsoring Club, by Event Location Sign or a Club Governor's Photo with you:
 - One [1] point for each day of a NCCC Event¹ cruised to; in or out of the SW NCCC Region. Extra points for mileage (from downtown Fort Worth) will be added as follows (mileage counted one-way only):
 - Miles: 100-299 = 1; 300-599 = 2; 600 & greater = 3 pts
- Two points for the following Corvette facilities: <u>National Corvette Museum</u> (NCM) or <u>Corvette Assembly Plant</u> in Bowling Green, KY (maximum of four [4] points per year).
- Five [5] points for being a Cruise Sponsor, up to five [5] cruises per year (max. of 25 points). This can be split between sponsors however; it can't exceed 5 points total.
- One [2] Point for each Historic Churches (maximum of 28 points).
- One [2] Point for each Veteran's, War, Police, Firefighter Memorial (maximum of 28).

Note: Please include the State each CCP point is located in on the log sheet – it assists in the end-of-year points validation.

10. Prize and Award Levels.

- 1st place "Top Cowtown Cruiser" Award *
- 2nd place "2nd Place Cowtown Cruiser" Award *
- 3rd place "3rd Place Cowtown Cruiser" Award *
- 100 points CCP Gold Level Recognition
- 75 points CCP Silver Level Recognition
- 50 points CCP Bronze Level Recognition
 - * Also includes above listed point awards and/or prizes given up through 100 points (all awards/prizes are subject to change)
- 11. This official CCP entry form and your NCCC number, name, eMail address and phone number must be included with entry. All log entries must be postmarked or delivered to the CCP Chair Person no later than midnight, 11/7/21.
- All photos are due on or before Monday, 11/14/21 (midnight), either in person or via Postal Mail.
- 13. Names of top winners and when to expect prizes will be published in the Cowtown Low-Down and on the Cowtown Website. All submitted photos / entries become property of Cowtown Vettes and may be used in the Cowtown Low-Down, the Cowtown Website or Cowtown's Photo Albums – the photos may NOT be returned.
- 14. IN THE INTEREST OF FAIRNESS, NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE TO THE PRECEDING RULES and rules will not be changed during the calendar year. The decision of the judges is final.
