## **FUNKHANA** --- WHAT???

A funkhana (fun-khan-a) is basically a similar type event as autocross but much slower, safe for any type car – not intrusive to the car like some autocrosses can be ©



These events usually involve a test of <u>very low-speed driving skills</u> such as backing, maneuvering thru cones, turning a 360 degree circle around a cone, parallel




parking, etc. They often also include gimmick activities such as ringtoss, putt-putt type golf, hula-hoop, hop-scotch, bean-bag toss, scrabble,


puzzles, etc. – basically driver and/or navigator teamwork.

These events are timed, usually with stop-watches which the participants start and stop. Funkhanas can be held car-less (no car at all) while others might have you start in a car and the rest of the event is done without a car, up until the finish. Most do involve driving your



car to stop points or "stations" where the driver and/or navigator will get out to perform the activity. Successful
