## **PRESIDENT'S REPORT**


I want to wish the membership a Happy New Year.

### **PROPOSED BY-LAWS CHANGE**

The following changes to the By-Laws and Standing Rules, Policies & Procedures have been approved by the Elected Officers. These changes will be presented for a vote at the January 2, 2009, Membership Meeting. Sufficient notification in the club news-letter requires the vote be postponed from December to January. If approved, changes will be effective immediately.

The following change to the By-Laws of the word "Patch" to the word "Award" requires approval by 2/3rds of the membership present at the Membership Meeting:

#### Current reading:

ARTICLE VI, 7.0 DUTIES OF THE NCCC GOVERNOR, Paragraph 3:

The NCCC Governor will assure all award purchases for Club competition events as approved by the Elected Officers. The NCCC Governor will be responsible for keeping track of Club members who earn a Club NCCC Travel Patch and will be responsible for the procurement of same. The NCCC Governor will also be responsible for keeping track of the points for NCCC Top Competitor and all NCCC competition awards and will present these awards at an Awards Banquet.

#### Proposed reading:

The NCCC Governor will assure all award purchases for Club competition events as approved by the Elected Officers. The NCCC Governor will be responsible for keeping track of Club members who earn a Club NCCC Travel Award and will be responsible for the procurement of same. The NCCC Governor will also be responsible for keeping track of the points for NCCC Top Competitor and all NCCC competition awards and will present these awards at an Awards Banquet.

The following changes to the STANDING RULES, POLICIES & PROCEDURES require approval by a majority of the membership present at the Membership Meeting. These changes update the word "Patch" to "Award" and simplify the Cruiser Awards wording, without changing the meaning.

#### Current reading:

3. A Club NCCC TRAVEL PATCH is presented annually to each member who attends eight (8) non-CTV NCCC weekends or 65% of the total number of non-CTV NCCC weekends that occur. A Weekend counts as one (1) event for each club hosting the weekend, regardless of the number of events. Participation is not required. NCCC Convention is counted as two (2) events for the purposes of this award. The award\*\* is given to an individual member and is presented at an Awards Banquet. The car depicted on the Club NCCC Travel Patch honors the Top NCCC Competitor for that event year.

#### Proposed reading:

3. A Club NCCC TRAVEL AWARD is presented annually to each member who attends eight (8) non-CTV NCCC weekends or 65% of the total number of non-CTV NCCC weekends that occur. A Weekend counts as one (1) event for each club hosting the weekend, regardless of the number of events. Participation is not required. NCCC convention is counted as two (2)

events for the purposes of this award. The award\*\* is given to an individual member and is presented at an Awards Banquet. The car depicted on the Club NCCC Travel Award honors the Top NCCC Competitor for that event year.

#### Current reading:

13. COWTOWN CRUISER AWARDS\*\* - There are two types of awards presented annually for the Cruiser Program, a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place Cruiser, which is a unique trophy signifying that they are the top three (3) competitors for that given award year. In addition, they also receive the Gold Level Cruiser patch for that given year. Members who reach one of the three (3) levels of Cruiser points will receive a patch for that given year. Patch Levels are:

(criteria remains the same)

#### Proposed reading:

13. COWTOWN CRUISER AWARDS<sup>\*\*</sup> - There are two types of awards presented annually for the Cruiser Program. A 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place Cruiser award is presented to the top three (3) competitors. Additionally, all members who reach one of the three (3) levels of Cruiser Participation will receive an award. Award levels are:

(criteria remains the same)

### **NCCC Newsletter Contest Rules**

- Each NCCC Club entering the contest will submit 3 issues covering the period from January thru May. For monthly newsletters, this would be January, March and May. For a bi-monthly, this would be the first three issues of the year.
- Each newsletter should be clearly marked "Contest Entry." We highly recommend that you place your newsletter in an envelope as several past entries have been damaged I mailing.
- All entries must be sent by standard mail. No registered, return receipt, postage due type mailings will be accepted. Addresses of the Judges will be listed below.
- The entries should be sent out, one issue at a time, as they are published. If you would like to verify that your entry was received, please enclose a self-addressed post card or envelope with each submission.
- The first issue must be postmarked no later than March 15, 2009. The final issue must be postmarked no later than June 1, 2009.
- Awards will be presented at the 2009 Convention in Colorado Springs, CO.
- A list of the Winners and all Entrants will appear on the NCCC Web Site and in Blue Bars.
- What the Judges will be looking for:
  - Entries will be judged on content and completeness in the following categories:
    - Local News: News of your club
    - Technical News: Repair—Replacement—Restoration—Tech. Information
    - Charity News: Any and all contributions to Charity.
    - NCCC National News: Contains items concerning items
    - Regional News: Your region news or other Regional news
    - Composition: Structure and content of your magazine
    - Scoring will be on a 10-point scale with 10 being the highest.

**The Cowtown Cruiser Program (CCP) enjoyed a record year** of participation for 2008. This was the fourth year of the CCP program and while everyone doesn't cruise for points, everyone is cruising to have fun in their Vettes along with enjoying fellowship with other members; we also represent Cowtown and promote fun in Corvettes.

The '08 CCP Statistics :

- 62 CTV Members participating
- 19 Guests participated (5 became members)
- 1,893 Total Cruiser Points
- 7 Sponsored Club Cruises
- 789 City / Town Points (177 out of state)
- 592 County / Parish Points (150 out of state)
- 82 State Points
- 334 NCCC / Social Points
- 30 State / Nat'l Park Points
- 50 Creek / River Points

- 16 Corvette Event Points
- 70 NCCC Nat'l Convention Points
- 4 Corvette Facility Points




