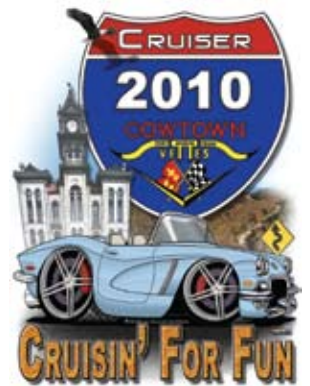
Top Cruiser Awards at the Christmas Party and Awards Banquet on December 11th.

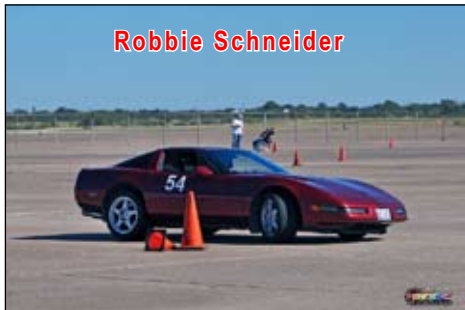

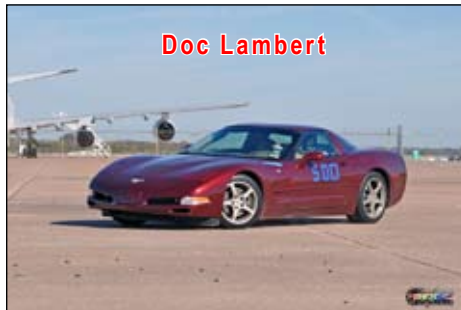
