C5 SECRETS

Did you know

1. The little yellow "helper light" on the bottom of the rear-view mirror that illuminates the shifter area

2. That you can put your key in the driver's door and turn it twice towards the front to unlock the passenger door and a third time to pop the trunk.

3. That you can pop the trunk and also pop the gas cap cover by pulling on metal lines hidden in the back.

4. The little slotted cover on the dash behind the steering wheel is where the inside air temperature sensor is located.

5. All of the option codes are in the glove box.

6. Tire inflation recommended pressures are on the driver's door

7. The thing that looks like a little LED near the DIC buttons is a light sensor

8. The thing that looks like a little LED near the defroster vent is a UV sensor for determining A/C usage to compensate for the heating effect of the sun


Please contact us if you would be willing to step up as a Functional Chairperson or a Worker in order to make these events a success for our club and our guests.

Helpful Hints - Why should I use historical markers? Take the time to stop and read historical markers. You will not only get extra points but you will learn about the area or sight where the marker is located. Historical markers will add an extra point to the state, county, or city point you list if the names of the state, county, or city appear on the marker. You must be at the listed

state, county, or city to get the points. If a city or sight is shown on the marker as a nearby city or sight you must go to that sight to get points for it. Example: On this site in Harris County the city of Houston was established as well as the nearby cities of Cypress, Pasadena, and South Houston. The only points you can claim are the county of Harris and city of Houston.

When entering the state, county, or city on your log place an "H" next to the name to receive the extra point.

2012 Annual Vette Photo Contest: The "What You Saw Along the Way" Photo Contest is also under way so you

need to be taking interesting pictures of your Vette while you are out cruising. You will find rules for the Photo Contest on our website. We welcome any suggestions for new cruise destinations or improving the program.

Tech Note

Recently noticed that my "head up display" (03 coupe) had stopped holding the gas gauge reading and slipped to the oil pressure display. Couldn't get it to stay put by resetting or even resetting the memory. About two weeks later I got into the 'Vette, turned the key, and VOILA, nothing. The battery was dead as a stone. After the new battery my "head up" has shown the gas gauge without fail. I suspect that when the battery gets low some things in the various multiple memories begin to reset. If that begins to happen to you, might I suggest checking the battery.


