



The Texas heat has finally been banished, being replaced with nice fall fresh air; so It's time to spend some time with the windows down or the top stowed as we cruise in our Corvettes. The National Corvette Museum would make a nice destination;

but if time and finances keep you local at least you might check out the redesigned NCM website. On the Home page you can Plan a Visit or Shop or Explore the events, exhibits, educational activities or check out the News or the Webcams. There is a Learn section for all your NCM questions and of course a Support section to donate or support the museum in other ways. I have recently been learning a bit about the future of the Corvette.

Actually, what I have been learning is all the conjecture about the future Corvette with the typical variety of opinions being expressed. Is there going to be a mid-engined Corvette? And if so; when? How about an electric Corvette? There are a variety of electric cars on the drawing boards of a number of luxury brand automobiles right now. The mid-engined Corvette has been rumored to appear in the 2018 model year as a \$200,000 specialty vehicle. GM says there is no mid-engine Corvette in the planning stages; but could a mid-engine car of another name be in the works? No comment from GM. How about an electric Corvette being planned? They're not saying. Personally, I think all manufacturers are developing electric cars. Many have said as much. Mitsubishi has officially stated that they will not manufacture any vehicle with an internal combustion engine by the year 2050. I think it will be sooner than that. Electric vehicles are the wave of the future. They are a disruptive technology just like Mr. Ford's first auto. It was disruptive to the buggy whip manufacturers; which all went out of business. Electric cars have no oil to change, no gasoline to buy; are very environmentally friendly and as the battery technology improves, like with the new Lithium Titanate battery, will have a range comparable to the cars of today. If you have solar panels on your roof; you can operate your electric car essentially for free. Of course, there will still be brakes and tires and wheel bearings etc. to service; but the cost to operate

will be so much less than today that they will quickly replace the internal combustion engine powered vehicles. In the 2017 or 2018 model year Ford, Kia, Toyota, Nissan, Tesla and probably Chevrolet will have a pure electric car that gets over 200 miles on one charge and takes less than three hours to charge on 240 volts at home for a price in the \$30K - \$35K range. Right now the 2016 Nissan Leaf gets an average of 107 miles on a single charge and takes three and one half hours to charge to full capacity on 240 volts. At charging stations at Walgreens and other retailers it takes 30 minutes to charge to 80% using 480 volts. But what about high performance cars, you say?

Formula E road race cars have been competing all this year. They operate at a maximum of 200kW which is equivalent to 270 horse power. They dial them down to 150kW for better battery conservation during the race and produce about 200 ft-lbs of torque and approximately 140 mph. They use regenerative braking to add to their battery capacity; so the E-race requires a different technique than drivers are used to. Big names are starting to get involved in Formula E like Michael Andretti and, of course, Sir Richard Branson. Check out the YouTube video of the race in Miami; they sound like the Millennium Falcon to quote an online commentator; but what about an electric Corvette?

Well, I think it is inevitable; but a long way off. There are too many people who will bemoan the loss of the growl of their Z06 and the long tradition of the internal combustion engine from the first Blue Flame in 1953 to the modern LS engine of today's Corvette. Personally, I hope to live to see an electric Corvette. I like the almost silent whine of an electric car, the lack of pollution coming out of the tail pipe, and the way all that torque silently slaps you back in your seat when you step on the accelerator. I bet one day in the not too distant future there will be a display in the National Corvette Museum all about the first electric Corvette. I hope I will be able to afford one; or, at least, talk one of you youngsters into giving me a ride in yours.

Additionally it makes for tight time-frames for our Governor to know who wins the annual awards, since the presentation of those is only 2 weeks after the event this year.

This date is the only spring date we could get to eliminate having to host our event either in the heat of the summer or again in November for next year. TMS has offered us the weekend following that last Thursday in April each year. One drawback, it is the annual Pate Swap Meet; which could also be a benefit. We will be having additional discussions with TMS to ensure our workers and competitors can easily get in and out of the infield area.

- June 11, 2016: the 5th Annual Corvette Scramble at Fat Daddy's. We had hoped to host this event on June 4th however a 14 event autocross weekend beat us out for the date.
- September 17-18, 2016: Our annual No-Frills Autocross Scramble with CCT which is typically held in the spring. We basically flipped the TMS & this event.


