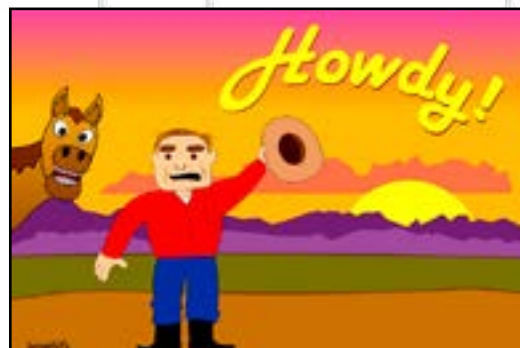

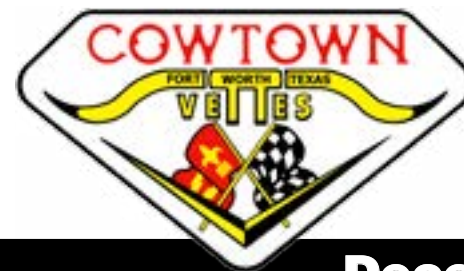

## COWTOWN CRUISER



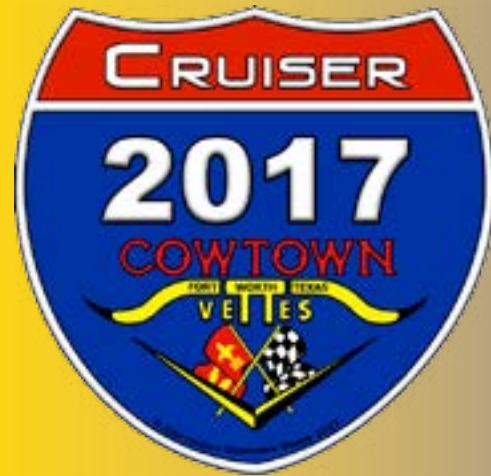

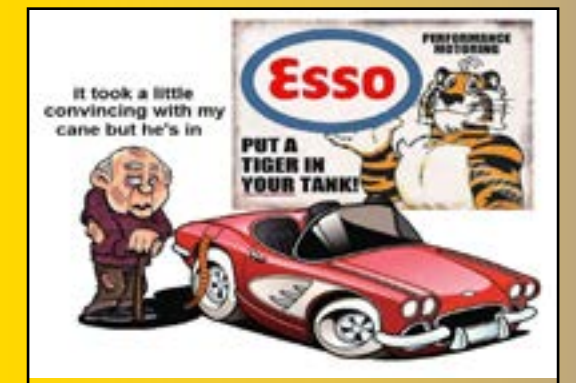

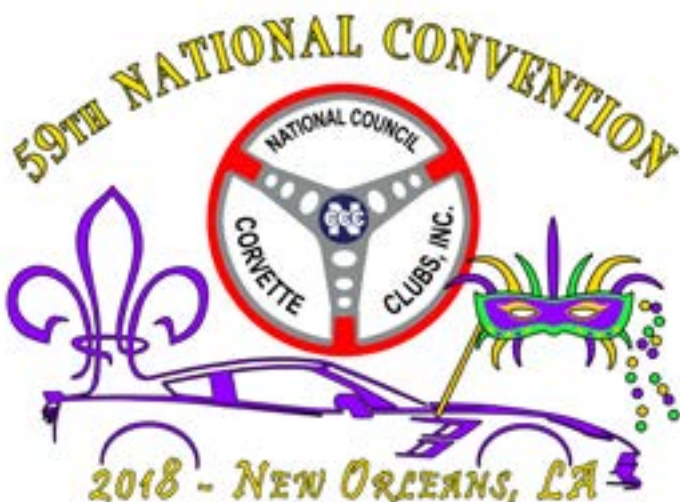
