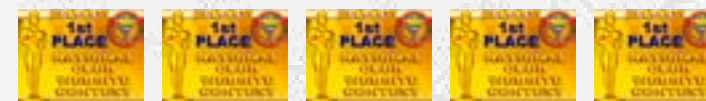

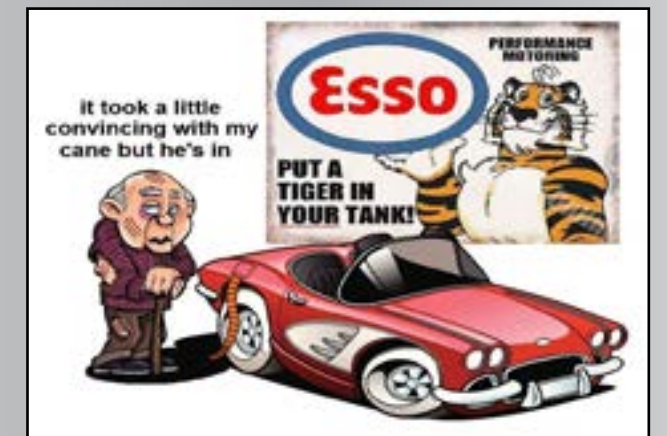

Then Cowtown rounds out the year, September 21-22nd with an event, probably in Mineral Wells but we are always looking for a new location!

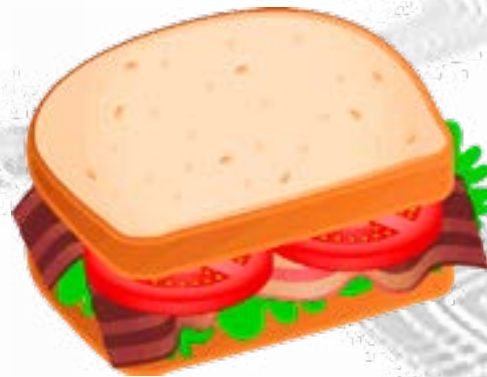
These events are our fundraising events for Cowtown. We can't do any of this without you and the membership!
