Blvd, Fort Worth**.

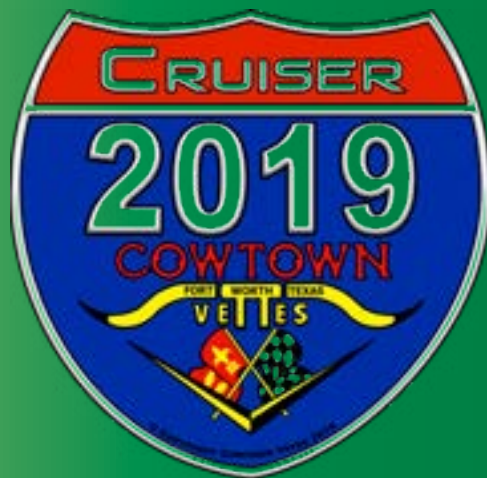


The dictionary defines the word “cruise” as “to sail about in an area without a precise destination, especially for pleasure, or to travel smoothly at a moderate or economical speed”. Sometimes it is more practical to have a specified destination and in the case of a Corvette the speed probably isn’t going to be moderate or economical....but it will always be for pleasure!

The things that need to be included in your photos are: 1) an identifiable portion of your Corvette 2) you 3) the Cruiser logo sign 4) an identifier of your location...ie city sign, county sign, historical marker. In order to be able to read the historical marker text it is beneficial to take an up close picture of it. Including a historical marker (in categories that allow them) and being out of state gives you an extra point in some categories. 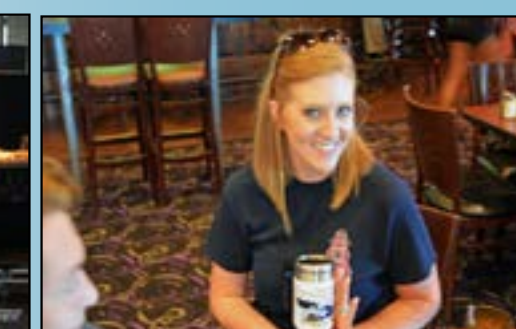
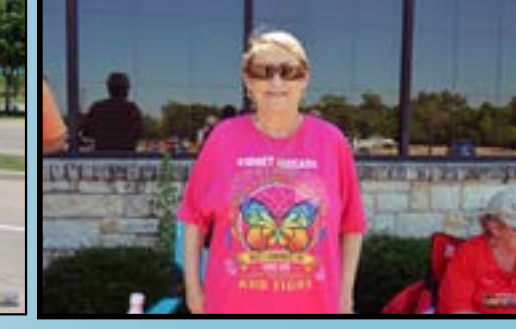
