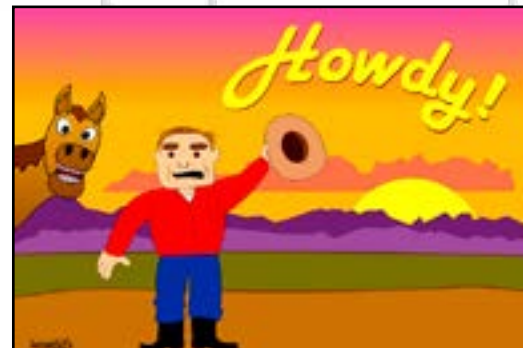

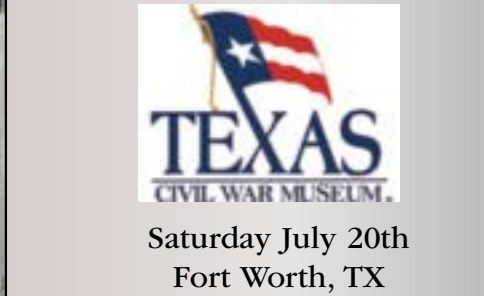

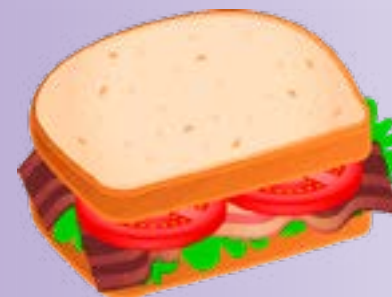
Welcome to the dog days of summer and a lull in NCCC events. Hope everyone is enjoying this fine Texas heat.
