





October is Car Show month! Hopefully Doug McMahan will lead a caravan of participants down to Granbury for the 14th Annual Corvette Show sponsored by the Brazos River Corvette Club on October 12, 2019. It is always a nice car show and Cowtown generally wins the award for largest club participation. The square in Granbury is also a great place for cruiser points. Photos may be submitted in a photo album or scrapbook form or digitally. They must be arranged by category/location and labeled as such. For specific questions you can refer to the website or direct your questions to the cruiser program chairpersons. Awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place as well as gold, silver and bronze awards will be presented in December.



Even if you are not chasing cruiser points you still have the opportunity to participate in the "What I Saw Along the Way" photo contest by submitting a photo of your Corvette in a scenic, interesting or unique setting. Each club member is eligible to submit up to 3 photos in a 4 x 6 or 3 x 5 format. Sometimes that spontaneous photo you snapped on your cell phone is just as interesting as some of the ones done with fancy equipment....Photos are due to the cruiser chairpersons prior to the start of the November meeting. Please put up your name on the back of each photo you turn in. The photos will be displayed during the meeting and members can vote on their favorite. Awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be presented in December.
