## Cowtown Vettes Fun Facts

Did you know:

- CTV official colors are red, black, white and gold...hence the colors in the logo/emblem
- CTV has a official emblem, but the emblem can be changed as long as the words "Cowtown Vettes" appear on the emblem...such as the years it has been changed to reflect a special anniversary year
- Cowtown members represent 30 cities in North Texas and beyond
- The club was chartered in 1974 and until his passing last December Larry Hoaldrige held the distinction of being the only continuous member!
- The original name of the club was Fort Worth Corvette Club, but differences of opinions early on created a split in the club to accommodate different interests
- CTV was number 1 in the nation in 1981 (more folks raced then)
- Despite the fact car clubs can sometime be labeled as "good old boy clubs", there have been several woman presidents through the years including current members Sylvia Hoaldrige, Debbie Lindsey and Kim West
- CTV has also been well represented nationally by female governors with women filling that position 18 out of 44 years (since they were not affiliated with NCCC the first 2 years). The governor with the longest tenure is current member Glenda McMahan

The Westcliff West Neighborhood Association's 4th of July Parade Saturday July 4th is scheduled, the details are on the website home page.




With the Lowdown online on the website, we can use context links that are active allowing you to click and open all the relative pages as you read. A printed version does not give the reader this cool option online.





## NCCC EVENTS


