Robert Geyer just returned from the Spring Mountain C8 Corvette owner school, he will be our April guest speaker.

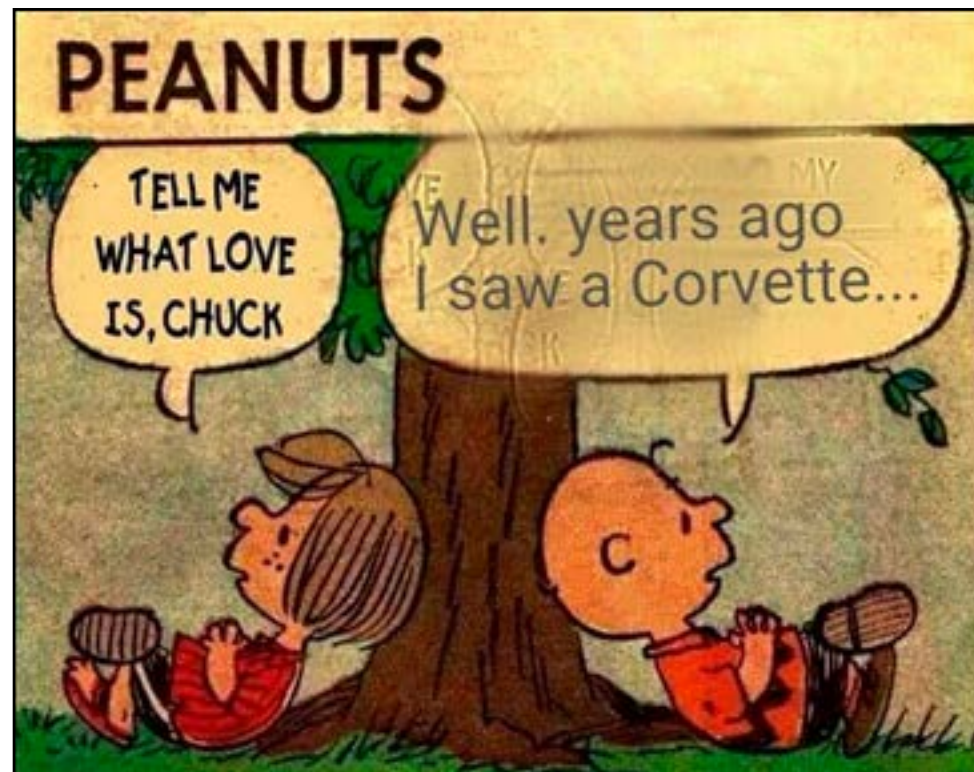
I talked with Lincoln Property and confirmed with Misty Renfro that we can have our annual car show on October 16th.

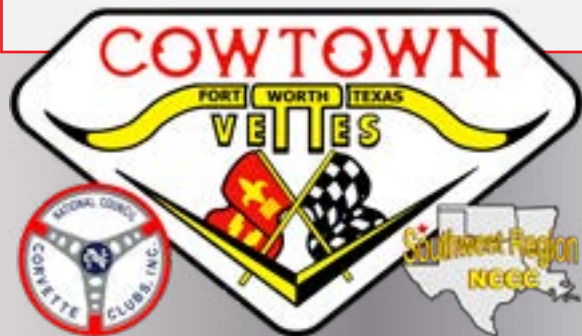


Cowtown's 2021 NCCC Event Dates – we invite you to mark your calendar for these fun events.

- Spring Scramble: May 15, 2021 – at Fat Daddy's in Mansfield – consisting of a Car Show, a Funkhana and a Gimmick and a Chance Rallye. This is a fun, event that allows some fun, laughs and testing your skills on the funkhana & rallyes. I will include some pictures from some previous year's events in the April Slideshow.
- Autocross Scramble: September 18-19, 2021 – TSTC Airport in Waco – consisting of 14 Low-Speed Autocrosses. The TSTC location is on the north-end of Waco. It is about the same distance for most of us as Mineral Wells was – plus TSTC has indoor restrooms and we have lunch inside the building.
- 1st Annual Larry Hoaldrige Memorial Event: April 24-25, 2021 – new tentative date of 11/6-7/21 – Please note that the only date we could find available at Texas Motor Speedway was in November. However, we are investigating a couple of other venues as alternatives for this event along with looking at a better date to host it. This will be our 24th annual autocross event at TMS.
