





## **NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM**

The National Corvette Museum showcases the Chevrolet Corvette, an American sports car that has been in production since 1953. It is located in Bowling Green, Kentucky, off Interstate 65's Exit 28. It was constructed in 1994, and opened to the public in September of that year. The National Corvette Museum was established as a 501(c)3 not-for-profit foundation with a mission of celebrating the invention of the Corvette; preserving its past.



NCM Exhibits: Last time I shared a unique exhibit experience, it was about Ed Roth's Rat

Fink Exhibit. Starting Memorial Day Weekend, they now have a "Corvette Powered Exhibit" at the NCM; so, what does that mean? From European and American sports cars to boats and motorcycles, the Corvette engine has powered more than just Corvettes over time. As explained by Director of Collections/Curator, Derek E. Moore, "this exhibit shares a piece of Corvette history and explores the stories of unique vehicles and their use of Corvette engines." Corvette Powered replaces Cartoon Creatures, Kustom Kars and Corvettes: The Art and Influence of Ed 'Big Daddy' Roth in the Exhibit Hall. Other vehicles to see in the exhibit include a 1958 Scarab, 1967 Bizzarrini Strada, 1965 Impala built by Chip Foose, 1969 Mangusta, and more. Visitors will be able to enjoy the Corvette Powered exhibit through Bash of 2022.



## NCCC EVENTS





It is with a sad note to share that due to the massive management changes out at TMS, it appears we have been totally squeezed out of hosting an event there in 2021. That being stated, the new management at TMS had also shared that a projected cost for facility use for the event would be estimated to be in excess of \$16k. That is a cost which cannot achieve break-even for the event, even if we sold out all 80 competitor slots. So, unfortunately, unless something changes for 2022, it appears that our days of the "Super Speedway Weekend @ TMS" will have come to an end. This is unfortunate after 24 years of holding events there and being the longest working group that works their professional events. However, we will revisit and continue discussions with TMS when they are ready to start booking for 2022; in hopes that something changes to our benefit.

We have been investigating other facilities and at this time, we have only bad news as the 1) price is either too high and/or 2) they have no availability for the remainder of 2021. We have contacted the typical autocross venues, like Motorsports Ranch, Eagle's Canyon, Lone Star Park, Baylor Stadium, etc. and none can accommodate us this year. I do have an outstanding inquiry to the City of Mineral Wells, asking for them to allow us to hold one last event at that facility; at this time, I have not heard back. If we can't secure this or another autocross capable parking lot / facility, we would need to consider another scramble-type event instead. We would like to hear your thoughts on non-autocross options.

We have swapped a few things around for the 1st Annual Larry Hoaldridge Memorial Event to rename the September Event, which is scheduled for the TSTC facility at the Waco Airport, rather than at the November Event. We will be utilizing all 10 of Cowtown's NCCC Sanctions in addition to others from CCT & BRCC to round out a 14-event weekend. The only catch at this time is for TSTC to provide the green light that they have opened back up and the events can be hosted there as scheduled.

Cowtown's Remaining 2021 Event Dates – we ask that you to mark your calendar for these fun events – to help make Cowtown Successful.

- 1st Annual Larry Hoaldridge Memorial Event: September 25-26, 2021 TSTC Airport in Waco consisting of 14 Low-Speed Autocrosses. The TSTC location is on the north-end of Waco. It is about the same distance for most of us as Mineral Wells was, not to mention TSTC has indoor restrooms and we enjoy lunch inside the building.
- TBD: November 6-7 2021. Unknown location / event type, as mentioned above.


