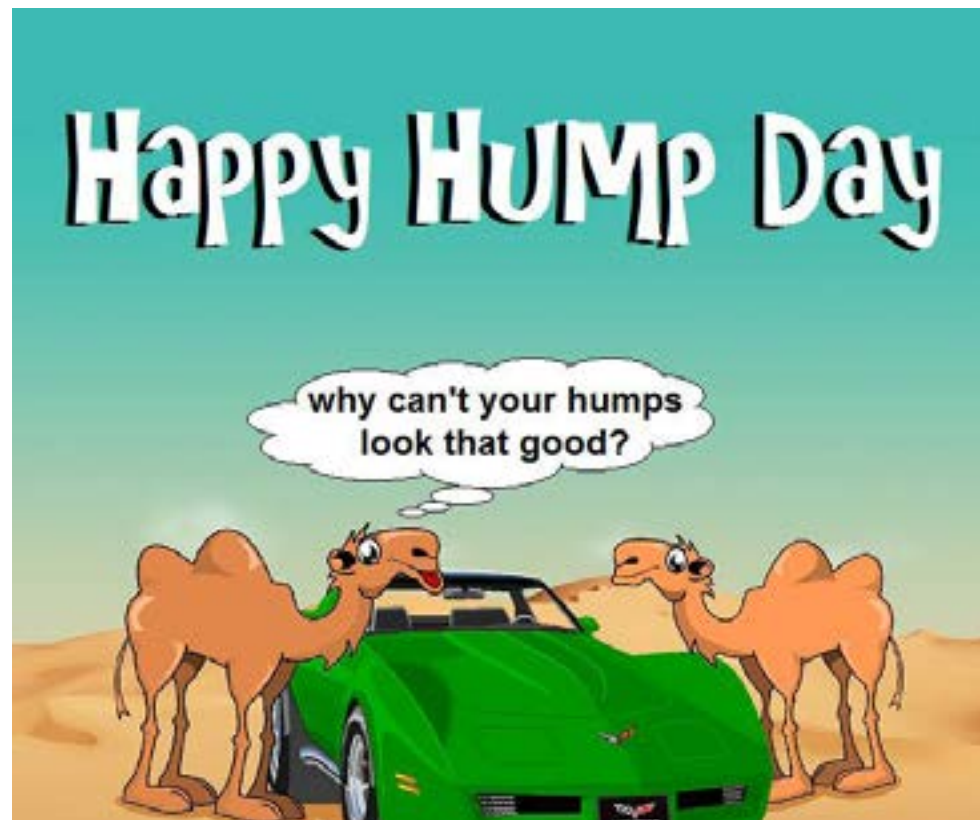
I am working on my last cruise of this year. Not sure of the date yet as we have a lot happening in September and October so keep a look out for my CTV ALL emails.

Last month we covered Watkins Glen and the C8.R Team placing 1 & 2. They also won Lime Rock for the sixth time and on August 21-22 Corvette VS Ferrari at 24 Hours Le Mans in one of the fastest races ran in GTE PRO ever on the Largest Stage around!

Early in the race Ferrari #52 had the windshield fog up and struck the #64 Corvette creating mechanical problems for the #64 Vette keeping it from contention for the rest of the race. Now Garcia in Corvette #63 worked up to third place behind the two Ferraris #51 & #52. Ferrari #51 was leading with Ferrari #52 blocking the #63 Corvette for most of the race. Two Ferraris and One Corvette...sounds like a fair race to me.

Finally... Garcia passed the Ferrari in the second chicane and never looked back from the halfway mark.



All night the Corvette team watched Garcia posted faster lap times than the lead #51 Ferrari and start to close the huge gap.

Pit set record times getting the #63 car out all night long as the #63 Vette closed in on #51 Ferrari...

Even the French said "Don't count these Americans out of it".



The #63 Corvette closed the gap but not enough. So after 24 hours of racing the #63 Corvette lost by 40 seconds and placed 2nd. The C8.R Team showed the fabric of a real winner and will be there tomorrow and the next race and the next race.

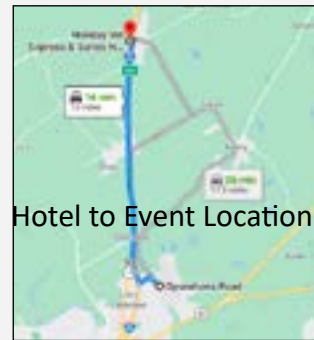
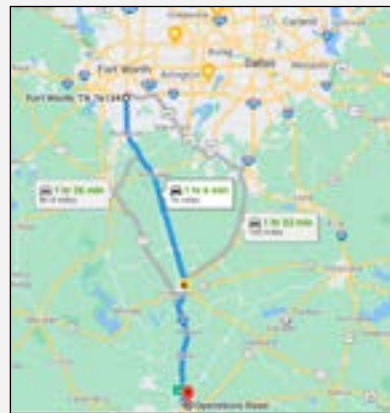
NCCC EVENTS
