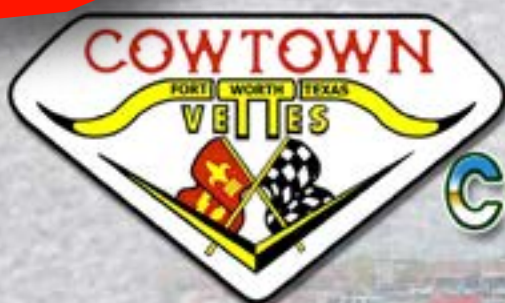

Although there are no activities scheduled for August, there is planning ongoing for September and October. Cowtown will be busy for two months or maybe longer.

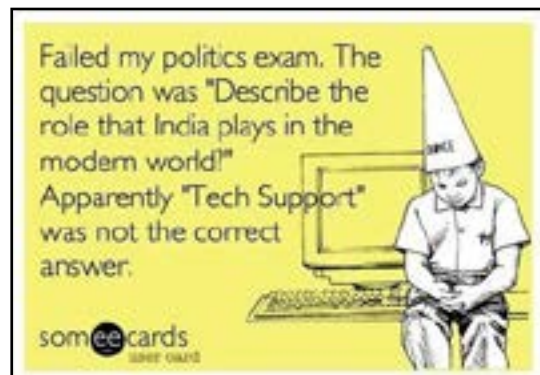
Hope all is well with all of you, I trust you are responding intelligently to the heat and keeping your fluid intake at optimal levels.

Corvette Racing Continues...Go yellow #3

Corvette Racing Takes First FIA WEC Win Of 2022 At Monza



Tommy Milner and Nick Tandy executed a difficult fuel-saving strategy to win the Six Hours of Monza on Sunday, giving Corvette Racing its first FIA World Endurance Championship win of the season.



The British English (he's from Bedford in Bedfordshire - pedantic Ed.) driver shadowed the leaders as he sat in third, with the race-leading Ferrari then coming into the pits and shuffling the No. 64 Corvette C8.R into second. A long stop for fuel and tires dropped the Corvette down to fourth in GTE Pro, but Tandy kept the leaders within reach until the third full-course caution of the race came out just shy of the two-hour mark.



Nick Tandy was sitting second on a difficult fuel-saving strategy when the race-leading Ferrari came into the pits for a splash of fuel with just two laps to go. This handed the lead to Tandy, who managed to nurse the Vette home on very low fuel to give the mid-engine Chevy its maiden FIA WEC victory.

"We fully expected the Ferrari to be able to go to the end. They had already done a stint under green to start the race and went a lap longer than what we could do even when we were saving earlier. We knew we had to be super-aggressive with the fuel numbers."

The FIA WEC season continues with the Six Hours of Fuji in Japan this September.

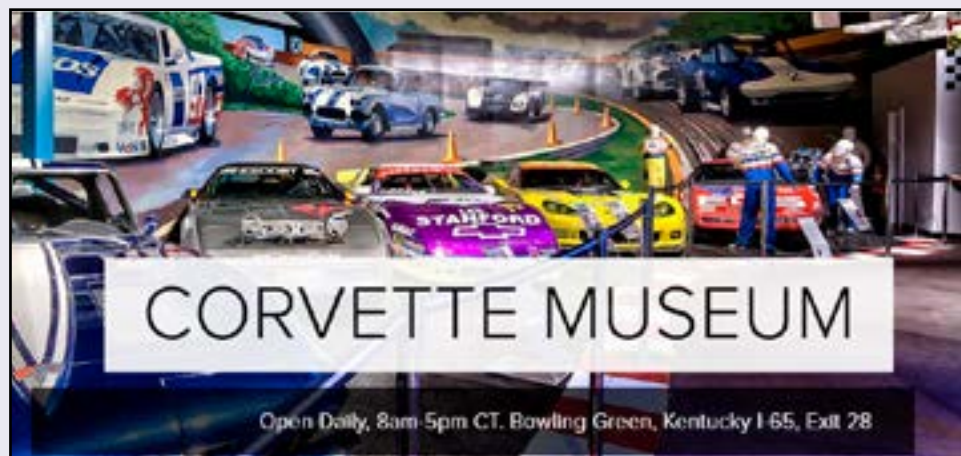
Howdy –

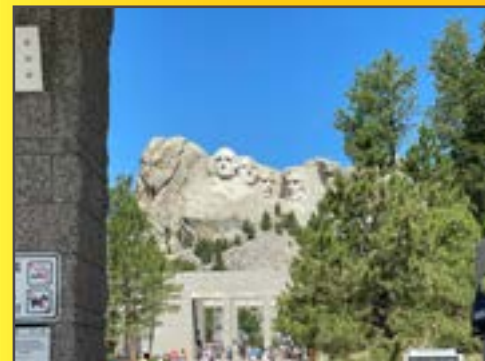
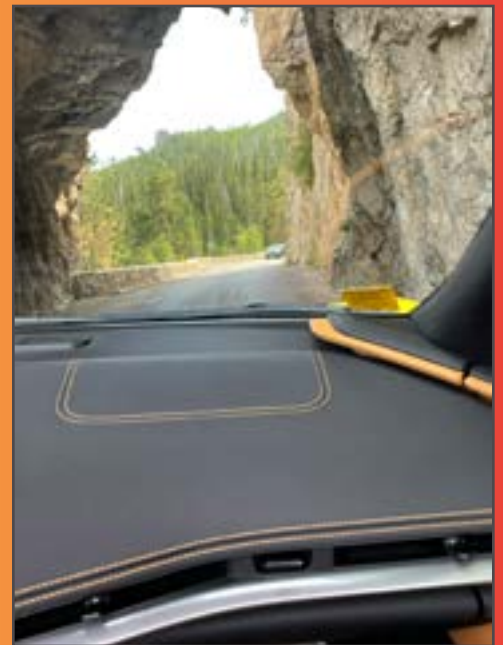

What is NCCC, and what does it mean to us as a club?

From their web site: *"The National Council of Corvette Clubs, Inc. (NCCC) was founded in the United States as an all volunteer, non-profit organization in 1959 by a small group of Corvette owners/enthusiasts! The purpose of NCCC was (and still is) to promote interest in Corvette ownership and operation, to publish information on the use and operation of the Corvette and to establish an organized effort to encourage others to participate in the enjoyment connected with the use and ownership of the Corvette ~ America's Sports Car!"*

NCCC is comprised of 16 Regions, consisting of about 250 clubs. Cowtown Vettes is one of 16 clubs in the Southwest Region. Cowtown Vettes is a 100% NCCC club, meaning that all members of Cowtown Vettes are also members of NCCC.

NCCC provides many benefits to its clubs and members. One of the main benefits is insurance. All of the venues we use for our events require us to be insured. Yes, even the car show venue requires us to be insured. Without NCCC, individual clubs could not afford to self-insure to hold these events. NCCC donates to charities, as do we, as a club. They print a quarterly magazine, Blue Bars, that is mailed out to every NCCC member. They provide scholarships for deserving NCCC member's family members. They offer a place for classified ads for members wanting to buy or sell a Corvette, or related parts. NCCC members are eligible for several discounts from hotels, to car rental, car parts, and other services.

If you haven't already, I suggest spending a little time on the NCCC website <https://corvettesnccc.org> . Everything I've mentioned here is covered there, and much more!

Crusin' the Arbuckles in Ardmore, OK was a great success. There were 4 Corvettes from Cowtown in attendance.

The flyer for Cowtown Corvette Rodeo is now up. It's the next NCCC event in our region, on September 17 and 18 at Tarrant County College, South Campus, followed by the Cen-Tex weekend at TSTC (airport) in Waco.

There are no changes in the Southwest Region Top 10. James Little is 2, Larry Schaapveld is 4, and Norman Walker is 5. For the ladies, Cathy Anthony is 7, and Kim Little is 10.
