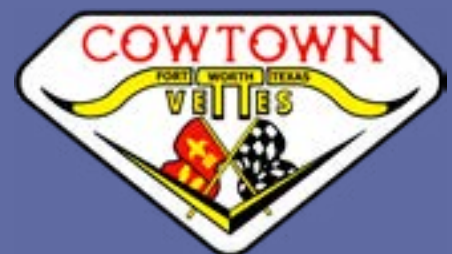

Corvette Racing Continues...Go yellow #3

Corvette Racing Settles for Second at VIR After Untimely Caution Wipes Out Lead



Antonio Garcia started from second position in the No. 3 Corvette C8.R for Sunday's two-hour, 40-minute sprint race, A yellow flag that came out for debris on the track with roughly an hour and 20 minutes remaining erased the Corvette's sizable lead. However, **Jordan Taylor** eventually worked his way back to the front of the GTD Pro field.



"We called the strategy well at the beginning and jumped ahead," Taylor said post-race. "If the race had gone green (to the finish), we would have maintained that track position, but the yellow kind of killed it. The car felt good, it's just frustrating to come up a little bit short again."

C8 Design Has Only Taken 70 Years but worth the wait !

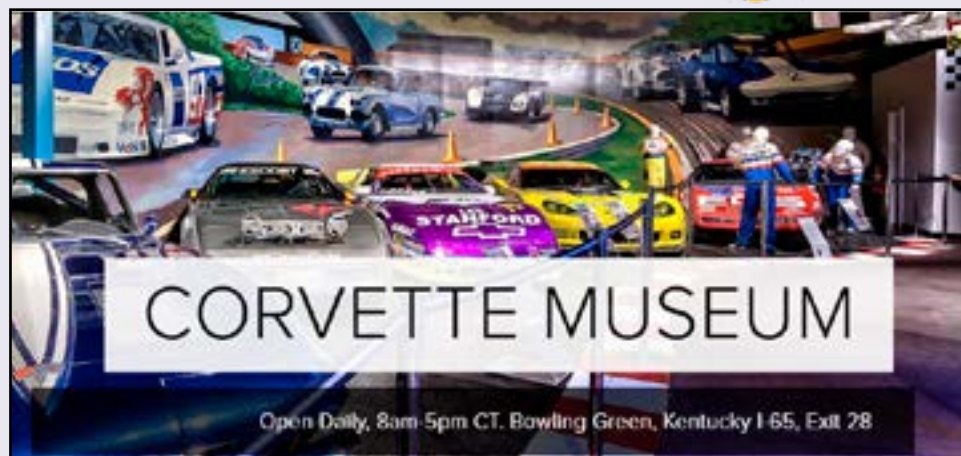
Reading three different articles from the NCM website, it continues to amaze how Corvette has been a work in process since 1953.

Ever wonder what happened to the 1983 version of the new C4? There were several issues as research, development and design just could not leap over. One article, on the NCM website, stated that a major culprit was the transitioning from the analog instrument panel to the digital age panel. Moving from a confusing graphical clusters to a bar graph making it easier for the driver to read vehicle stats quickly and efficiently. LED lights were not available so generating enough light in the panel became an obstacle that Chevy didn't want to compromise. So basically, due to this and other design factors, no 1983 production cars.

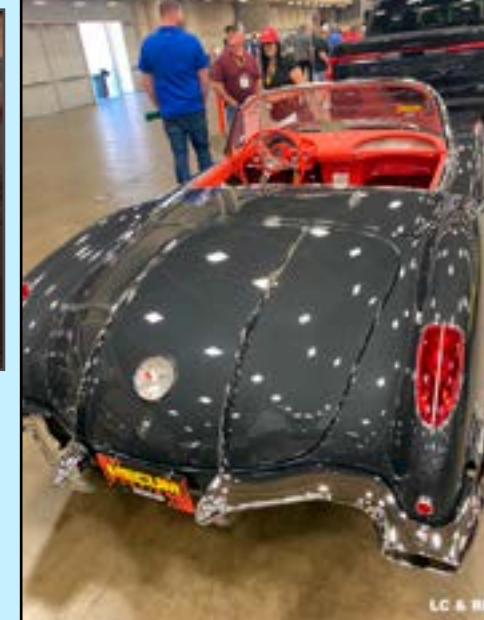
