

I am looking forward to serving as your Vice President/Social Chairperson for 2023.







Hello '23 Goodbye '22 !

January finds us preparing for the events of 2023. Actually, much work was done in 2022 for this upcoming year. All dates are set and approved and contracts for venues have been signed.

Our first event is the practice autocross on March 11th, at Azle High School. This is two parking lots with a good transition from one to the other. It will not be a fast course but will have lots of turns and carousels. Should be good for beginners and practice for the experienced. The purpose of the practice autocross is not only for the drivers but for anyone who is interested in assisting and participating in the NCCC functions as a worker. There will be opportunity to learn timing, staging, starting, corner worker, course set up and tear down, registration, proper radio use, stopwatch timing and more. Hopefully we will have good weather and it will be an early chance to bring your car if only as a spectator and enjoy the day with fellow Corvette owners.

Last year our Spring Rally at Fat Daddy's was well attended by club members and out of towners with almost 30 cars in the car show and 15 teams in the funkhana and rallies. This year it will be a two-day event with each day having 2 car shows, a funkhana and 4 rallies. Potentially an individual or team could win 51 points with a total of 102 points for the weekend. This is being done in the Region and Nationally to make the non-autocross participant more competitive for Regional and National awards. This event should attract all regional point chasers and maybe some national participants.

It would appear that NCCC affects only a few club members, but my rough count is that there was over 75 members involved in NCCC events in '22 either as participants, workers or spectators. The liability insurance provided by the NCCC membership dues affects all members who participate in any club activity. I hope more and more members participate in our NCCC events
