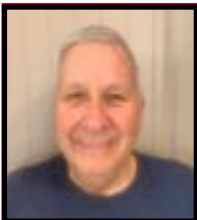

The name Zora or Zorro brings back visions of a Spanish masked crusader, a master swordsman who roamed Spanish colonial territories standing up for the poor and common man. Can't tell you how many hours of TV we probably wasted watching him do his thing and finishing the job with a swipe of the sword into a slash of the Z. But so many of you know, there was another guy, Zora making a name for himself also during the 50's and 60s.

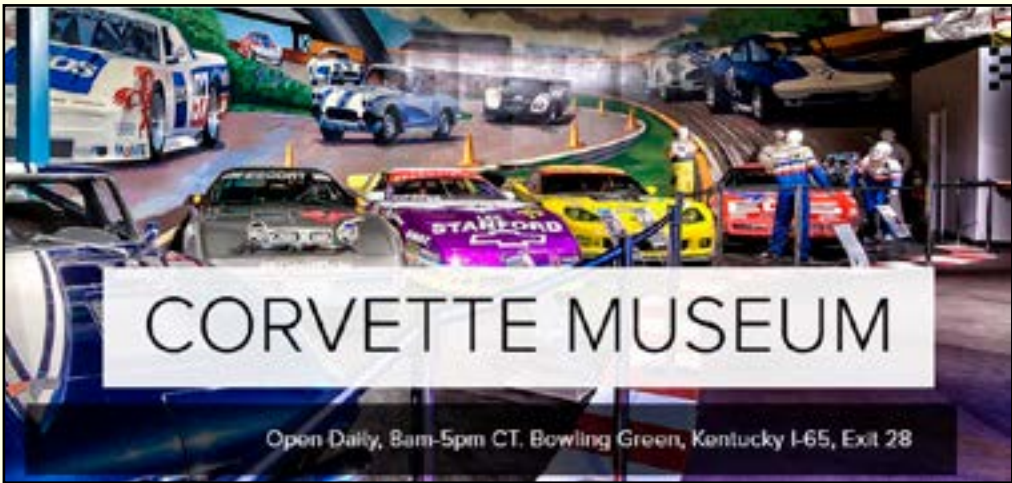
Zora Arkus-Duntav a Belgian born former race car driver turned Corvette engineer was busy turning the early Corvettes into a performance car. Taking the little Chevy to new heights by installing a small block V8 engine in the 1955 edition. This along with tons of other Corvette innovations earned him the title "Father of the Corvette". He didn't invent the Vette, that was Harley Earl but he sure made his mark by making it the American dream car legend.

His contributions are still being honored with rumors of an upcoming 2025 Zora Corvette bearing his name. This version has hinted of a 1000hp hybrid supercar with gas and electric power. Just like our old superhero Zorro did in the 60's, the name Zora and his contributions continue to excite and raise our adrenaline levels. His story probably deserves at least a mini-series on Netflix.

A little known fact about Zora, is that his ashes are actually entombed at the National Corvette Museum with an obituary that states – "if ... you do not mourn his passing, you are not a good American".

The mark of the "Z" might reappear in our future on the 2025 C8 supercar. If any of us get one, we may be a Superhero too .... in our mind anyway.

By the time you are reading this, the Fall Festival weekend event in Edmond will have been completed. The only events left, after Edmond, are the autocross/drag event in Killeen and Holland on October 21 and 22, and the season finale will be a fundraiser at Edmond on October 28 and 29.

The SW Region standings of Cowtown and Cowtown members have changed, since competition resumed in the SW Region.

In the men's competition, Cowtown members still occupy SIX of the top ten spots!

James Little -1, Dalan Walker - 4, Rick Whitcomb - 5, Larry Schaapveld - 6, Red Greenfeder - 7, and Norman Walker - 10.

On the ladies' side, Lee Ann Parker - 2, and Cathy Anthony - 7.

As a club, Cowtown is still Number 1 in SW Region, and have actually increased our lead over Number 2, Oklahoma City Corvette Club.

The National standings have changed. We have 2 men, and no ladies in the top 15. Rick Whitcomb - 11, and James Little - 12. Numbers from last weekend's events have not been added. As a club, Cowtown is Number 3, with a slight lead over number 4.

There are numerous change and clarifications being voted on in the Competition Manual and Bylaws. Most notable are changing the number of sanctions from 10 to 14, allowing riders who are competing in autocross events, eliminating helmets from funkhanas (below 10 mph), and several others.
