Tommy Milner took control of the <u>Corvette</u> Racing machine, when he lost power, forcing him to slow. To add insult to injury, the No. 3 C8.R was leading the GTD class at the time of its mechanical failure, having led 87 laps to that point.

dise.


Special Guests: Expect appearances by prominent figures in the Corvette world, such as former

Currently, there are 160 Cowtown Vette Members. Renewals are still very slow so far, and by the time you're reading this, the early renewal period will be over. Do not fear, you can still renew, there will just be a small \$10.00 late fee.

The final NCCC event of the year will have been held in Edmond, OK on October 28 and 29, before you are reading this. It is a SW Region fundraiser. Half of the profits from this event will go to the SW Region Scholarship Fund!

The SW Region standings of Cowtown and Cowtown members have changed, and will change again, after the points from the Killeen/ Holland events are added.

Currently, in the men's competition, Cowtown members still occupy SIX of the top ten spots! James Little -1, Dalan Walker – 4, Rick Whitcomb – 5, Larry Schaapveld – 7, Red Greenfeder – 9, and Norman Walker – 10.

On the ladies' side, Lee Ann Parker – 2, and Cathy Anthony – 8, and Kim Little - 10.

As a club, Cowtown Vettes will finish Number 1 in SW Region, over Number 2, Oklahoma City Corvette Club. The national standings have changed. We have 2 men, and no ladies in the top 15. Rick Whitcomb – 11, and James Little – 14. Numbers from last weekend's events have not been added. As a club, Cowtown is still Number 3, with a slight lead over number 4.

The numerous changes and clarifications have been voted on (electronically) in the Competition Manual and Bylaws, and we should learn the results at the November Governor's Meeting in St. Louis. Most notable are changing the number of sanctions from 10 to 14, allowing riders who are competing in autocross events, eliminating helmets from funkhanas (below 10 mph), and several others. These can be found on the National NCCC website if you are interested. Also, we will learn who the new VP of Competition will be. Jack Alexander and Rene Cardenas are running.


