Road Race wrecks

Rumors and resignations abound about the Big Bend Open Road ty Links Race, scheduled for April 2008. The four race directors have resigned. Kenda Furman, Race Coordinator; Randy Archer, Race Director; George Luera, Assistant Race Director and Mike Dominguez, Chief of Technical Inspection submitted verbal resignations to BBORR Board members Tony Villarreal and Leo Smith last week.







The following is an email from Terrell County Judge Leo Smith,

who has been chairman of the BBORR Board of Directors. He and Tony Villarreal are the only remaining active Board members.

Here is the post that all of you have dreaded and not wanted to see.

As of 7:05 pm Tuesday, February 19, 2008 The BBORR and the Road Runner are both officially canceled and there is no sign of them ever taking place again.

The Board has discussed the options, and this is the decision. It is not an easy decision to make but given all the facts and obstacles that are being thrown in our way there is no way for this to work. There are numerous factors that are in play and I will try to explain them to you the best I can.

First, there is a new administration in Fort Stockton. They had to deal with issues concerning this race that they were not familiar with. The timing of Kenda quitting caused these issues to be brought front and center, and the commitments to move forward could not be addressed in time to get the ball rolling.

Kenda has always done a fantastic job running this race but in quitting the City of Fort Stockton at this time, doesn't leave enough time to replace her before the race.

These issues and timing were the kiss of death on the future of this race.

All of the negativity about safety issues resulted in our safety crew not wanting to participate, thus causing our permit with TxDot to be null and void.
